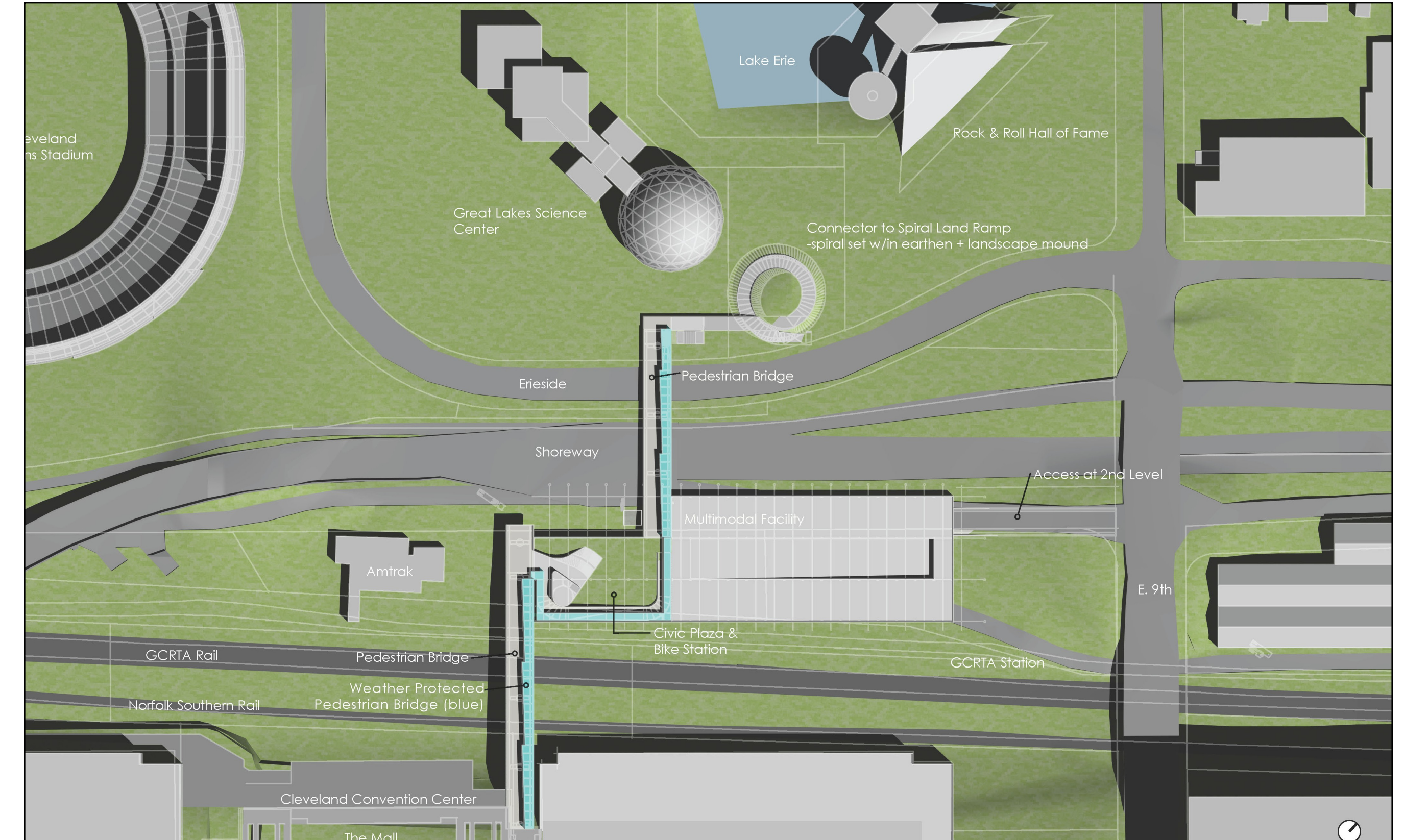
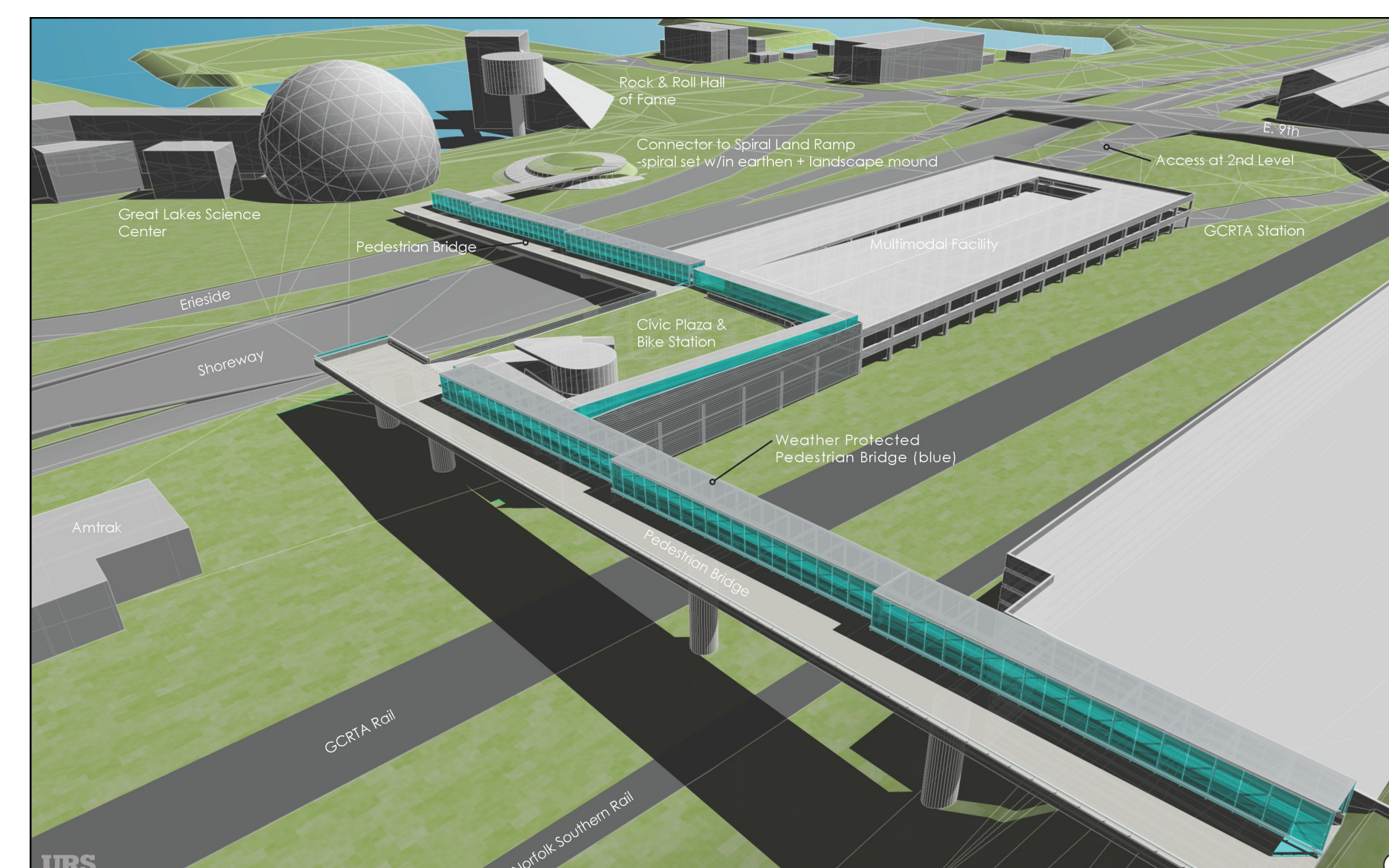
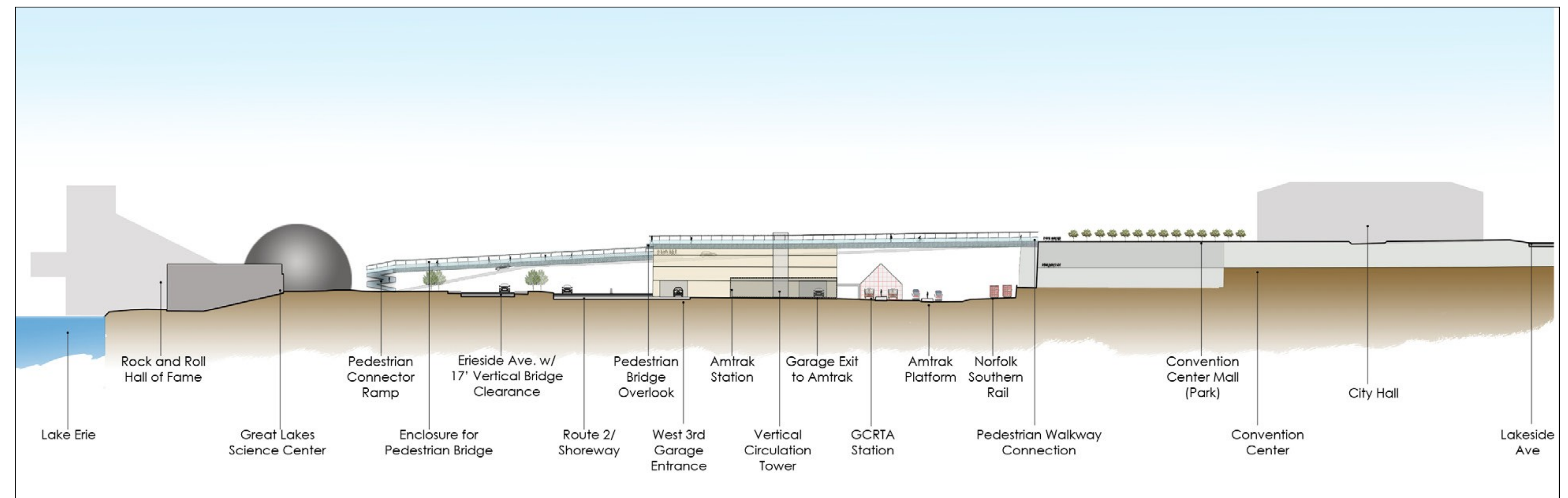


Cleveland Downtown Lakefront Multimodal Project



The Multimodal Project will:

- Provide ADA-compliant pedestrian and bicycle access between the downtown Civic Center at the Mall and the Lakefront. Accommodating a 51.5-foot vertical transition and spanning a 600-foot wide transportation corridor.
- Incorporate bicycle rental facilities for visitors.
- Link major civic outdoor venues.
- Improve access to Amtrak and GCRTA Waterfront Line rail service.
- Provide roadway safety improvements with the removal of a short 300-foot weave between the Shoreway/SR-2 mainline and access ramps for downtown streets.
- Maintain cargo handling capabilities on cross-country freight rail lines and the Port of Cleveland's international docks as well as regional highway access to downtown and the lakefront.
- Provide public parking supporting the Cleveland Medical Mart & Convention Center and lakefront visitor venues.
